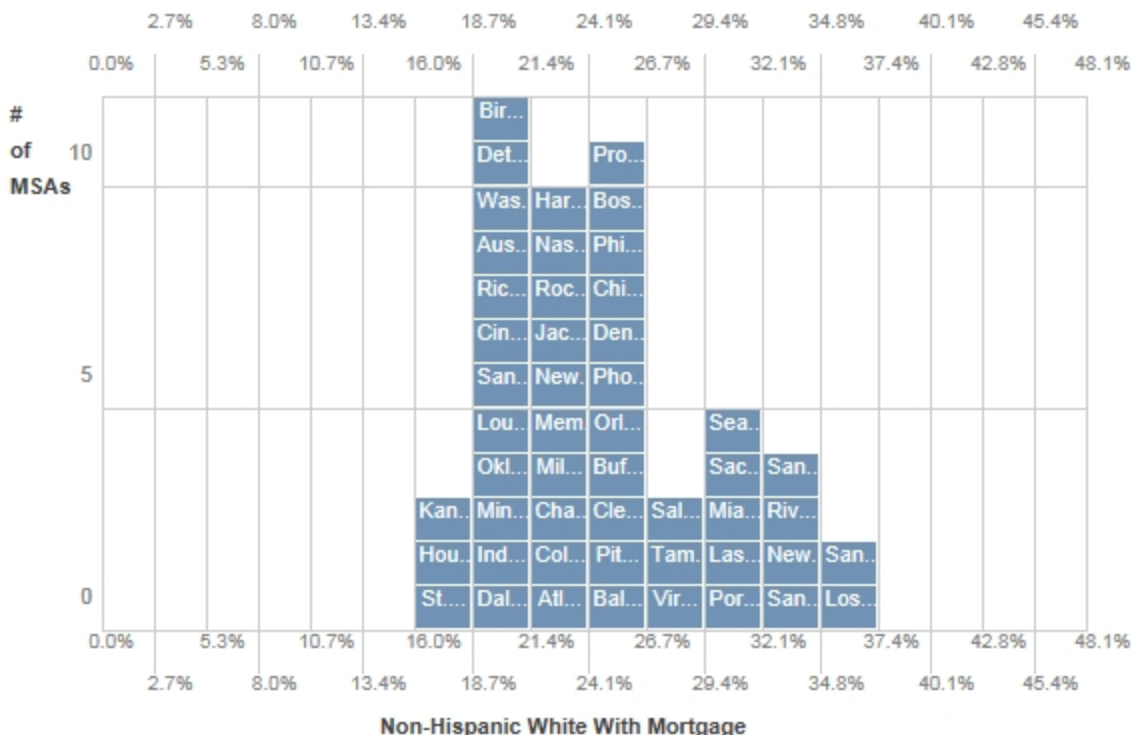


Share of Owners Paying More than 30% of Income for Housing by Race/Ethnicity and Mortgage Status
